

June 21, 2025 15th Annual Fishing Tournament Rules

Treasure Coast Chapter Florida Engineering Society

1. Each Team will attempt to present 1 snook length, 1 trout length, 1 redfish length and 1 tarpon length (Pictures are required for out-of-season species and undersize fish, but it is the responsibility of the angler to provide clear, dated picture next to ruler/scale). Each Team may also attempt to present up to five (5) legal offshore game fish of the following species: dolphin, cobia, snapper, grouper, kingfish, wahoo and tuna. Up to five (5) of these fish can be included to account for a maximum total weigh (in any combination) to be weighed at the CAPTEC dock. In other words, the Team can present up to five (5) of these offshore game fish in order to record a maximum total weight. All State and Federal Laws Apply. (Billfish and Sharks do not count).
2. Two awards will be presented: one (1) for longest aggregate of snook, trout, redfish and tarpon length and one (1) for heaviest total weight of five (5) legal offshore game fish species listed above.
3. Lines in the water 7:00 AM. Honor System, there will be no check-in before fishing.
4. Weigh station opens at 3:00 PM and closes at 4:00 PM. This means you must be checked in with whoever is keeping the weight log before 4:00 PM. Weigh-in will be at CAPTEC Engineering Dock. (Lat. 27°12'33.01"N Long. 80°15'35.39"W).
5. The Weigh Masters word is final.
6. All baits are legal (live, artificial, dead). All State and Federal Laws Apply.
7. Dead fish can be weighed in at no penalty and must be edible (properly kept on ice). If you leave fish out to spoil, you will be disqualified.
8. If you weigh in an illegal fish, you will be disqualified.
9. If you are caught or if we have a legitimate reason to believe that you or your team cheated you will be disqualified.
10. All participants must have a valid State of Florida fishing license.
11. Disabled tournament boats that do not make the 4:00 PM weigh-in will not be allowed to weigh their fish.
12. Teams that help a disabled boat and arrive at weigh-in after 4:00 PM will be allowed to weigh their fish. However, they need to make contact with Jon Milton at (772) 485-8382 ASAP!
13. "Snoopy Rod Calcutta" - The winner will be determined by the **Longest Overall Length** of a single fish of any Florida game fish species caught on a Children's Cartoon Character Rod & Reel Combo (**Overall Rod length not to exceed 36", original reel must be used, relining is allowed**). Rod and reel shall be of the same type and size as shown on first sheet of the flyer. Only Cartoon Character Rod & Reel Combos are allowed. Angler must present Rod & Reel Combo at weigh in to verify it was used in original configuration. Tournament Fish may be caught on a "Snoopy Rod", the weight or length will be counted for tournament portion and the length will be counted towards the Calcutta. Fish need not be presented at the check-in, BUT a clear photo of the fish lying adjacent/atop a discernible measuring device verifying the length must be provided to determine the overall length of the fish, with the final decision to be made by the tournament committee. **Please note that each boat is responsible for having a digital camera and measuring tape/stick on-board if participating in the Calcutta.** A tournament offshore fish that is caught on the "snoopy rod" must be weighed in at the dock on the tournament scale; a digital photograph will not suffice for tournament consideration. Calcutta Fish can be measured at the dock if you so choose, if you do not intend to keep and eat the fish it is your responsibility to keep the fish alive for proper release. **NO CATFISH OR REMORA FISH WILL BE ACCEPTED FOR THE SNOOPY ROD CALCUTTA.**
14. THIS TOURNAMENT IS FIRST AND FOREMOST A FUNDRAISER FOR FES SCHOLARSHIPS. IT IS THE DESIRE OF THE TOURNAMENT COMMITTEE TO LIMIT ENTRANTS TO THOSE IN THE ENGINEERING COMMUNITY AND TO THOSE INVITED TO THE EVENT.
